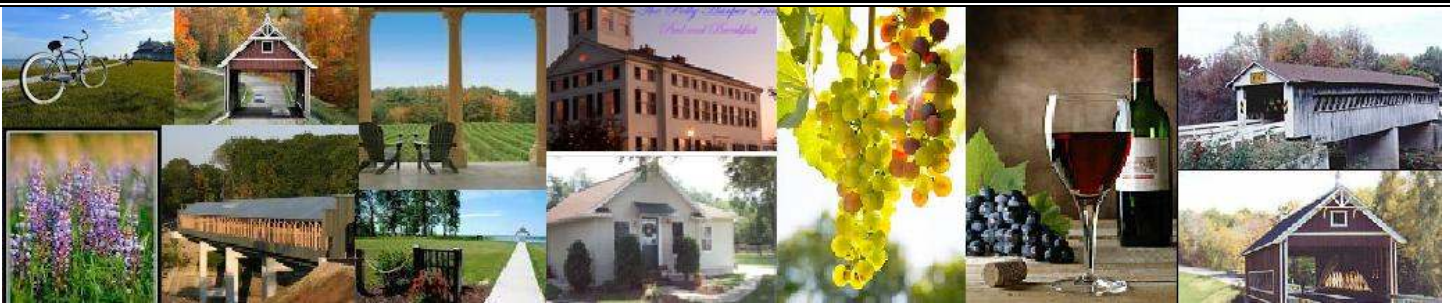

Currently he is a certified Emergency Manager for the State of Minnesota, serves as the Emergency Manager for Hennepin EMS, is a FEMA certified instructor, and holds a BA in Organizational Leadership.
